## Statement of Faith

- We believe the Bible to be the inspired and only infallible, authoritative Word of God. (2 Timothy 3:15)
- **We believe** that there is one God, eternally existent in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. (John 10:30)
- We believe in the deity of our Lord Jesus Christ (John 10:33), in His virgin birth (Luke 1:35), in His sinless life (Hebrews 4:15), in His miracles (John 2:11), in His vicarious and atoning death (Ephesians 1:7), in His resurrection (John 11:25), in His ascension to the right hand of the Father (Mark 16:19), and in His personal return in power and glory. (Revelation 19:11)
- **We believe** that for salvation of lost and sinful man, regeneration by the Holy Spirit is absolutely essential. (John 3:16-19)
- We believe in the present ministry of the Holy Spirit, by whose indwelling the Christian is enabled to live a godly life. (Romans 8:13-14)
- **We believe** in the resurrection of both the saved and the lost; those that are saved unto the resurrection of life and those that are lost unto the resurrection of damnation. (John 5:28-29)
- We believe in the spiritual unity of believers in our Lord Jesus Christ. (Galatians 3:26-28)

## **SINCH Behavioral Expectations**

Colossians 4:5-6 states "Walk in wisdom toward those who are outside, redeeming the time. Let your speech always be with grace, seasoned with salt, that you may know how you ought to answer each one."

Matthew 22:37-39 states "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all you soul and with all your mind. This is the great and first commandment. And a second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself."

We, the members of SINCH, seek to nurture the character of our children and represent Christian values to others. Consequently, both parents and children should respect the following guidelines while attending any SINCH sanctioned event. If unwilling to do so, they may be asked to leave by the event coordinator or a member of the Council.

Those who participate in SINCH activities are asked:

- 1. To respect their bodies, dressing modestly and appropriately.
  - At summer and beach activities:
    - i. Preferred length for shorts would be no shorter than the tips of your fingers while your arms are at rest beside your body
    - ii. 1 piece or tankini swimsuits are preferred for females, swim shorts are preferred for males
  - At all events it is preferred that pants are at the waist and not hanging off the buttocks with underwear/boxer shorts exposed
  - At all events females are asked to keep cleavage covered
  - At formal or semi-formal dances ladies are asked to choose dresses that:
    - i. cover cleavage
    - ii. have at least one strap over the shoulder
    - iii. have a tasteful back
    - iv. are close to the knee or longer
- 2. To respect their bodies by abstaining from the use of tobacco, alcohol and all illegal drugs. (1 Cor. 6:19-20)
- 3. To speak carefully, honoring the name and character of God by avoiding profane and vulgar speech. (James 5:12)
- 4. To act appropriately, practicing courtesy and respecting the property and regulations of others. Any behavior that is threatening, or can reasonably be perceived as threatening, shall be subject to disciplinary action by the SINCH council. Consequently, any object being used as a weapon, or in a manner considered inappropriate by a member of the council or any person entrusted with leadership of an event in progress, will be confiscated. Firearms are restricted from events except as explicitly allowed by law and/or as required by the nature of the event. (Eph. 5:15-16)
